CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND

THE TAREE SHOW SOCIETY IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANISATION. ALL MONIES RAISED ARE USED TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN THESE FACILITIES.

Taree Showground is a designated "Glass Free" area and NO glass drink containers are permitted.

NO liquor is to be brought onto the Showground.

The M.R.A.& H. Society Taree Inc Committee reserve the right to inspect and confiscate containers being brought onto the Showground suspected of containing liquor.

Liquor must ONLY be consumed in the designated licensed area.

NO liquor is to be consumed or carried in the Sideshow area.

Drunken, unruly, offensive or fighting will result in removal from the Showground.

Anyone providing alcohol to a person under 18 years of age will be removed from the Showground.

Any person directed to leave the Showground as a result of these regulations is forthwith barred from the Showground. Any re-entry prior to the committee lifting such barring will be deemed to be trespassing and Police will be notified.

Any person already under the influence of alcohol will be refused entry to the Showground.

The speed limit for vehicles on the Showground is 10kph. Any form of reckless driving is prohibited.

Juveniles under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

By entering the Showground, all persons agree to abide by these regulations.

3. Entries should not exceed 90cms X 120cms
4. All Entries can be For Sale clearly labelled with the Artist's Name, Class, title, Medium used, priced and ready for hanging.
5. The Show Society will retain 10% commission on Sale of Works.
6. Every care will be taken of works submitted but the Society will not be responsible for any Damage or Loss.
7. The Committee reserves the right to exhibit any piece of work on Television or in the Press or any other Media.
8. All entries shall be Judged but the Society reserves the right to withhold work from being hung.
9. The Judges decision if Final and No Correspondence will be entered into.
10. Any matter not covered by these Conditions of Entry under the Art Section or the General Conditions of Entry will be adjudicated by the Chief Steward.
11. All Exhibitors must sign a waiver before entries will be accepted.
