CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND

THE TAREE SHOW SOCIETY IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANISATION. ALL

MONIES RAISED ARE USED TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN THESE FACILITIES.

Taree Showground is a designated "Glass Free" area and **NO** glass drink containers are to be brought onto the site.

The M.R.A. & H. Society Taree Inc. Committee reserves the right to search for any prohibited item including but not limited to weapons, controlled, dangerous or illegal substances, alcohol bottles and cans which may be expressly forbidden and subject to confiscation.

NO alcohol is to be consumed or carried in the Sideshow area.

No person under the legal drinking age is to attempt to purchase and / or consume any alcohol at the Showground. If of age, he or she will not consume such quantity of alcohol as would give rise to a blood reading above the legal limit allowable in the State for control of a motor vehicle, or such quantity which would adversely affect his/her ability to drive a motor vehicle, whichever is lesser.

Alcohol must **ONLY** be consumed in the designated licence area.

Drunken, unruly, offensive behaviour or fighting will result in removal from the Showground.

The M.R.A. & H. Society Taree Inc. Committee reserves the right to refuse admission without explanation and to eject any person whose conduct the Committee or a member of the Committee deems disorderly, unruly, offensive or any person who is adversely affected by alcohol or otherwise behaves in a violent or threatening manner.

Any person supplying alcohol to a person under the legal drinking age will be ejected from the Showground.

Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

The speed limit for vehicles within the Showground area is 10 kilometres per hour.

Any person ejected from or directed to leave the Showground is therefore banned from re-entering the Showground until such time as the Committee of the M.R.A. & H. Society (Taree) Inc. has lifted the ban. Such person shall thereafter be treated as a trespasser and Police will be notified.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Electric fence and portable yards are not allowed on the showground. This is essential for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Work Health and safety Act 2011. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitor who does not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the showground.

ELECTRICAL Equipment & Power leads any exhibitor/competitor intending to bring electrical equipment on to the showground is required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers, and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor.

PLEASE READ ALL DETAILS OF SCHEDULE CAREFULLY. ALL EXHIBITORS AND THEIR ASSISTANTS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN A WAIVER FORM BEFORE BEING ALLOWED INTO THE JUDGING RING.

Planning for our 2019, 140th Taree Agricultural Show is well underway and we are contacting you with some important news regarding your Entries for this years event.

Due to recommendations from the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Ltd we will be enforcing compulsory testing for Pestivirus.

This means all cattle attending the Taree Agricultural Show, that Exhibitor/s must provide a copy of the lab report for each animal entered for competition prior to the entry being accepted. No report means your entry will be rejected.

It is also a directive of the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Ltd. that a copy of the NVD/Waybill must accompany your Entries.



Stud Beef Cattle **Rules & Regulations apply to ALL BREEDS**

Cattle to be exhibited at the Show must be free of Johnnes Disease.
Certificate is to be forwarded with entries.

All Cattle must be pesti-virus tested

All Exhibits must be the Bona Fide property of the Exhibitor and must have been in their possession for at least one (1) month prior to the Show.

Exhibitors must supply particulars regarding name, pedigree & age of the animal on the entry form.

All stock must be registered with their respective Breeds' Societies.

The age of Stud Beef Cattle shall be the actual age up to and inclusive of the 1st October, 2019.

A heifer is considered a female that has not had a calf and is not over three (3) years of age.

A calf under eight (8) months of age must parade with it's mother in the cow classes.

Age of calf to be actual age up to and inclusive of 1st October, 2019.

All Cattle must be on the ground by 8 am, Saturday of the Show.

All Exhibits must be available for inspection to persons nominated by the Society at anytime, for any reason.

If any Exhibit/Exhibitor is not ready to parade when class is called, then the class will go ahead without that exhibit/exhibitor.

Female beef cattle must be haltered and led with approved nose grips fitted.

All Bulls over twelve (12) months must have a ring fitted.

It is recommended that the minimum age for leading bulls in the general beef classes is 12 years of age as at the date of the show, unless otherwise stated.

Neck straps must be used on all cattle stalled overnight in beef cattle sheds.

Exhibits to be stalled in designated area.

Sawdust bedding is provided by the Show Society.

On any protest relative to age, the Judge reserves the right to mouth any exhibit and make a final decision.

All people restraining cattle shall be effectively trained and able to do so.

The Society will not hold itself responsible for any loss or mis-delivery of livestock or other exhibits at the Show or damage thereto.

Any matter arising that is not covered by these Rules & Regulations will be determined by the Chief Steward.
